

Performance Audit of Sustainable Urban Transport

Audit Objective:

To assess the Government efforts in development and management of outer ring toll road and development of battery electric vehicle infrastructure to support the achievement of sustainable urban transport.

Audit Scope:

Activities related to development and management of outer ring toll road and development of battery electric vehicle infrastructure to support the achievement of sustainable urban transport from 2019 to 2021.

Audit Criteria:

The criteria are derived from relevant regulation and best practices related to development and management of outer ring toll road and development of battery electric vehicle infrastructure. The criteria addressed the following aspects:

1. Policy and planning;
2. Funding;
3. Implementation; and
4. Monitoring and evaluation.

Significant Findings:

1. Policies and regulations concerning development and management of outer ring toll road and development of battery electric vehicle infrastructure to support the achievement of sustainable urban transport have not been integrated and coherent.
2. Toll tariffs determination policy has not incorporated the sustainable transport aspects.
3. Incentives and financial support on the development of battery electric vehicle infrastructure have not been adequate.

Audit Recommendations:

1. To evaluate the development planning and management of outer ring toll road and the development planning of battery electric vehicle infrastructure.
2. To incorporate the aspects of sustainable transport to the determination of toll tariffs.
3. To encourage the private sector to develop the battery electric vehicle infrastructure by providing necessary incentives.

Management Response:

The management accepted the recommendations and will follow up accordingly.
