From April to October 2018, it carried out an audit at the then responsible Federal Ministry of Sustainability and Tourism and at the processing and administration centre for green electricity OeMAG Abwicklungsstelle für Ökostrom AG with regard to green electricity as exemplified by wind power and photovoltaics.

The audited period essentially spanned the years from 2013

Central recommendations

(1) Feed-in tariffs should be more consistently pegged to cost-efficient plants and the most efficient sites in order to ensure an efficient use of funds and a continuous increase in production. Subsidies for renewable energy should therefore also be granted via a tendering process.

(2) As to the creation of the future subsidy system, a system of checks and balances free of any conflict of functions and roles should be established for the bodies of the processing and administration company. Furthermore, public interests should be safeguarded.

(3) Transparency should be created on the direct and indirect costs of the development of
